NPSD Odyssey of the Mind Teams Perform Well at States And Qualify for World Competition

The North Penn School District is excited to announce that two student teams competed at the Pennsylvania State Odyssey of the Mind Competition on April 10, 2010 and qualified for the World competition!

In addition to receiving first place for their problem, the Penn Dale Middle School team was also awarded the Ranatra Fusca Creativity Award for outstanding creativity. Out of the entire state tournament, only three such honors were given. It was such a proud moment for this team. The Ranatra Fusca Creativity Award represents the essence of the Odyssey of the Mind. It is presented to teams or individuals who exhibit exceptional creativity, either through some aspect of their problem solution, or an extraordinary idea beyond the problem solution. A successful problem solution is not a criterion for winning the award; rather, the award is a way to acknowledge and encourage creative thinking and risk-taking.

These performances have qualified both teams to compete in the World Competition held at Michigan State University in May. The students and parent coaches are thrilled to be a part of this exciting opportunity.

KYW Newsradio Awards Scholarship to NPHS Senior

Congratulations to North Penn High School senior **Shayne Dwyer**, who was recently awarded with the KYW Newsradio Richard Monetti Scholarship. Dwyer, one of the 171 students to graduate from KYW Newsradio's 2010 Newstudies program, received a \$2,000 college scholarship. The award was announced at the Newstudies Graduation ceremony on April 6th at The Franklin Institute.

The Richard Monetti Scholarship is awarded every year to the Newstudies student who demonstrates the most potential and enthusiasm throughout the six-week student reporter program. The scholarship is named for Richard Monetti, a 1986 Newstudies graduate who was killed in the bombing of Pan Am Flight 103 over Lockerbie, Scotland, in 1988. Richard's parents, Bob and Eileen Monetti were on hand to announce the winner of the 2010 Monetti Scholarship.

KYW Newsradio 1060 has given high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to learn the inner workings of a major market radio and TV station through this program for nearly four decades. On six consecutive Saturdays beginning in February, students from high schools throughout the Philadelphia region come to KYW to learn news writing, reporting, ethics and interviewing skills from station managers, editors, reporters, anchors.
